The Tokomairiro High year 13 students involved in peer support cut their holidays short this week to attend school on Monday to be further trained in the Peer Support programme, in order to lead it in the school this year.

Peer Support is the programme, which teaches senior students to help younger students develop the skills, knowledge and confidence to get along with people around them. It offers emotional and moral support to the year 7 students and assists in their orientation into the high school. Its goal is that through a series of well-planned lessons, challenges, games and conversations, that barriers are let down and more confident and self-managing students develop. The school has been involved for over 20 years in this programme, thanks to the financial support of the Milton Rotary Club.

A number of staff members put in their time on Monday and were impressed with the students sensitivity, confidence and willingness to learn new things, to familiarise themselves with the

equipment and to begin writing lesson plans for their first session. They have planned some fun games to play for the first day of school, which the year 7 students attend.

The school anticipate a successful Peer Support programme in 2014 judging by the enthusiasm and early commitment shown by our senior students.
