White Sunday Celebrations

12th October

This Sunday the Tokomairiro Co-operating Parish will celebrate White Sunday. The service, starting at 10.30am will be held in the Presbyterian Heritage Church followed by a shared pot luck lunch in the Milton Church Hall. All folk are warmly invited.

White Sunday is said to be a tradition in the Protestant churches in the South Pacific, where all the children wear white. Its origin is debatable, but its emphasis is very important and is seen as another aspect of Christian Education for both young and old.

In Samoa, White Sunday is also known as 'Lotu Tamaiti' – (Childrens' Service), where the congregation and community acknowledge and celebrate the crucial role and place of children within their context. It is one of the few times within the worship context of a congregation, the children are given the opportunity to minister to parents and families, through scripture, skits or re-enactment of Bible stories, memory verses or *tauloto*, and sometimes creative dance and song.

It is also one of those times the children are allowed privileges normally reserved for elders, such as, being the first to be served food at family mealtime, and also being given gifts or receive gifts.

The celebration of White Sunday has changed through the years. It has also become a time of commemoration for loved ones who have passed on, or a time for family reunions and reconciliation, or new beginnings.

All are warmly welcome to this service this coming Sunday.

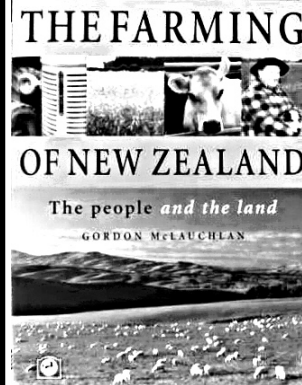

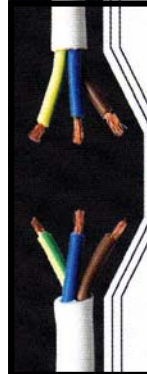
