## Celebration of Ruth's Connection to Tokomairiro High School.

It was wonderful to have a celebration of the contribution Ruth Robins has made to our school, last Thursday afternoon. Ruth has had a very long connection with Tokomairiro High School. Not only has she worked for the school for just over 35 years, Ruth's connection goes back many years before that time. Ruth began at Tokomairiro School as a 6 year old. She continued through to the high school section of the school and in 1958 Ruth was named Dux of the school.



Liz Jack shared some of her thoughts and memories of Ruth with us. Ruth's dedication to and love of the job was clear. She never took a day off. The only times she was "missing" was when she was called out on ambulance duty. Ruth's efficiency was legendary – she would have things done almost before she had been asked to do them. The vast community and institutional knowledge that Ruth has is invaluable. She has certainly worked with two or three generations of families in the wider Milton community. Ruth's competency, especially with her St John's qualifications, was a real bonus for the school. She became the first port of call, not only for the minor medical issues, but also for the more serious incidents. Ruth was always calm and assured. The other thing we found out about Ruth that afternoon was that she was a NZ Representative Netball Umpire. She used to umpire the staff-student matches and she certainly never let the staff away with any of their tricks!

Ruth was the Board of Trustees secretary for many years and our past BOT chairperson, Jill McIntosh, spoke very highly of the work Ruth did in that role. Thank you to the other staff and community members who also shared stories of Ruth and her time at Tokomairiro High School.

To finish off the afternoon Ruth gave us a history lesson. What a wonderful opportunity to hear first-hand about the school and the buildings as they were in Ruth's school days.

We would like to say a big thank you to this amazing person for what she has brought to, and done for, our school and community.

I wish to thank all those who said so many kind things at my send off from Tokomairiro High School. Glenis (the Principal) for her comments. Liz Jack (ex DP) who said so many nice things - even some I had forgotten about - she has such a good memory. Bob Jack about his involvement in encouraging me to be treasurer of the PTA and to be secretary of the Board. Jill McIntosh commented regarding her and my involvement with the Board operation and the fact that I had worked at the National Bank with her Mother when I left school. Thank you most sincerely to the school for the park bench they are about to erect. I will be able to sit on my bench and oversee the operation of the school. The PTA, as usual, put on a marvellous afternoon tea. Thanks a million.

I did not think that I would have as many great friends come and visit either with beautiful flowers or masses of food or baking. There are too many to name individually but thanks to you all so much. I am so lucky to have such marvellous friends and a great job as such a great school.

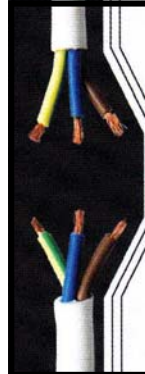
