FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Tena koutou katoa

The term break is over and term three has begun. I hope all the students and staff had a happy and restful break and have returned feeling refreshed and ready for the term ahead. We are now more than halfway through the school year for our senior students. It is imperative they focus on their study as they head towards their external examinations in term four.

Interviews

Interviews are on Wednesday 3 August. Book online at www.schoolinterviews.co.nz

The event code is: **x7bge**. Alternatively, you can ring the school office, 417 8620, to make an interview appointment. It makes a huge difference to students' achievement if parents and students work together with teachers. I encourage you all to take this opportunity to meet with the teachers. Please book an interview so that we can make this year as successful as possible for your child.

Attendance

We are continuing to have our focus on attendance over the second half year as we believe attendance has a huge influence on achievement. The school target is to have at least 90% attendance per student. For term two we had 113 students who had at least 95% attendance, 22 having 98% attendance, 11 having 99% and 22 having 100% attendance. This was a great effort, especially in the winter term.

ERO Review

Our school Education Review Office visit is planned for week 3 of term 3 (8-13 August). The reviewers will check our school's self-review systems as well as review the teaching and learning that is happening in our school. We have very

thorough self-review systems and know that our students will be only too happy to share their learning. The reviewers will also talk with parents and whanau members, as well as interviewing the students.

Learning Curve

This week's Learning Curve Lesson titled "People You Meet" focuses on building positive relationships with people we meet. As individuals, to flourish in our lives, we need to be able to build healthy relationships with different types of people and accept and value diversity of approach, attitude, culture and willingness to contribute. The lesson talks about how "*other people matter. Most are friendly, some are irritating. Both your and their wellbeing*

relies on building positive and cooperative relationships."

There is a reminder that **you** can only change **your** attitudes, not the attitudes of others. There are also some great suggestions about how to deal with others difficult attitudes to try and build positive relationships.

The clear message is that nearly everything you will achieve in life will come from working well with people, from the relationships you build with others.

NZQA FEES

All NZQA fees need to be paid to the school office by **Monday 5th September 2016**.

The fee is **\$76.70** unless you qualify for financial assistance as explained below.

Financial Assistance

Who can apply for financial assistance?

Financial assistance is available to assist with the payment of entry fees for National Secondary Schools qualifications. To be eligible to apply you must be the fee-payer and meet at least one of the following criteria:

Be receiving a Work and Income, or Study Link benefit (benefit-based applications).

Have a joint family income that would entitle you to receive a Community Services Card (income-based applications).

Be a fee-payer with two or more children who are candidates, irrespective of family income (multiple candidate applications), where the total fees you would have to pay would otherwise be more than the \$200 multiple candidate maximum.

You cannot claim financial assistance for international fee-paying students.

How Much Will I Need To Pay

If you qualify for financial assistance and have **one** child who is a candidate, you will pay **\$20.00**.

If you qualify for financial assistance and have **two or more** children who are candidates, you will pay a maximum of **\$30.00** per family.

How Do I Apply For Financial Assistance

Complete an application form (available from the school office) and return it along with your money to the Tokomairiro High School office.


