Check Your Smoke Alarm Batteries

A reminder to check your smoke alarms

As daylight saving comes into effect, firefighters want to remind our readers that now is a good time to check or install smoke alarms.

The New Zealand Fire Service attends around 3,800 house fires every year. In over 80% of those fires, smoke alarms were either not installed or not working.

Most fire fatalities occur in homes while people are sleeping. The smell of smoke won't wake you up. Working smoke alarms give occupants the early warning they need to get out of the building safely in the event of a fire.

Smoke alarms need to be cleaned once a month to get rid of dust, small insects or spider webs that may affect the performance of a smoke alarm. At the same time push the test button to ensure the smoke alarm is in good working order.

If you don't have long-life smoke alarms, you need to change the battery at least once a year. We recommend you change the battery in your smoke alarms at the start and end of daylight saving. An easy way to remember when they are due.

If you have any problems one of your local Volunteer Firefighters will be happy to assist.

Daylight saving starts this weekend, on Sunday 25 clocks go forward at 2am.

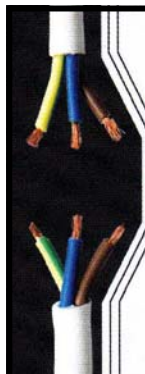

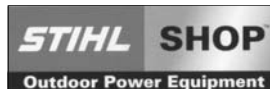
