AGRICULTURAL TERTIARY EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

For any pupil of Tokomairiro High School who chooses to follow a course at any Agricultural Tertiary Education Institution, ie, University, Polytechnics, etc.

Criteria

The scholarship is designed to encourage pupils of Tokomairiro High School to further their education at any recognised agricultural tertiary institution, and to this end, the criteria the Tokomairiro A&P Society are Agriculturally based.

Qualities which will be looked at are:

- Academic Excellence
- Leadership
- Stability
- Being involved within the Teen Ag Club at Tokomairiro High School.

Hardship is taken in to consideration.

It is presumed that applicants will come from year 13, although this may not necessarily be the case.

Scholarship Details

The scholarship is a once only payment of \$1000 for the students first year of study and will be paid directly to the successful applicant in June of their first year of study.

The scholarship will be awarded annually at the Tokomairiro High School prize giving if a suitable applicant has been accepted.

Applicants will be required to complete the application form and may be required to attend an interview. The scholarship will be known as 'The Tokomairiro A and P Society's Agricultural Tertiary Education Scholarship'.
